Eli Groner is Israel’s Minister for Economic Affairs to the United States, based in Washington, D.C. Mr. Groner was confirmed by the Israeli Cabinet for this position in August 2011. Mr. Groner came to the diplomatic role by way of the private sector, where he worked most recently in private equity and management consulting.

Prior to his appointment, Mr. Groner served as a special advisor to the Chairman of Tnuva, one of Israel’s largest food manufacturers and distributors, and one of the country’s most well-known companies. In his role, he developed and oversaw implementation of its three-year strategic plan, and sat on a number of the organization’s steering committees.

From 2003-2009, Mr. Groner was a consultant at McKinsey & Company, where he served a breadth of Fortune 1000 corporations from around the world, as well as many of Israel’s leading companies. Mr. Groner focused on strategy, marketing and operations for some of the world’s leading technology, healthcare, financial services, and consumer packaged goods companies. While at McKinsey, Mr. Groner was also selected to lead firm-wide training for early tenure consultants.

Eli served in the paratrooper corps from 1989-1992, where he received a citation for outstanding performance and exemplary leadership.

Mr. Groner has an MBA from New York University where he was a Director’s Fellow. He received a BA in political science from Bar-Ilan University. Eli is married to Tamar and they have five children.
