LYOVA ROSENTHAL By Murray Siegel

Recently, Turner Classic Movies showed the 1967 film In the Heat of the Night, starring Sidney Poitier and Rod Steiger. The female lead who played Mrs. Colb, the widow of the murder victim, was Lyova Rosenthal, although you will not find Lyova's name on the cast listing since she changed her birth name to Lee Grant. Lee's father was the son of Polish Jews and her mother was a Jewish immigrant from Russia.

Lee appeared in her first movie, Detective Story, in 1961. That same year she made derogatory comments about the House Un-American Activities Committee and was blacklisted, causing her limited acting opportunities for the next twelve years. When her career restarted, she won two Emmys and an Oscar for her acting prowess.

At the time this article was written, Lee was alive and looking forward to her 98th birthday in October. She has been married twice and has two children.


