

## **Message from Our Rabbi**

### **Sukkot Gives Meaning, Purpose to Our Lives**

Sukkot is one of three pilgrimage holidays – a time set aside to reconnect to our roots. A time for coming together to rejoice and give thanks for all that we are and all that we have. And much more.

It is different than the other two pilgrimage holidays, Passover and Shavuot. Passover commemorates the concept of freedom. Shavuot acknowledges the purpose of our existence, our religious identity. Sukkot, on the other hand, incorporates the meaning of the other two and adds a significant dimension – Sukkot emphasizes the tenuousness of our lives, the fragility of our existence and the temporariness of our sojourn.

Sukkot is also a reminder of God's protection. Just as the Sukkah we erect gives us shelter, God attempts to shelter us from the consequences of our choices. Just as the temporary dwelling reminds us of how precarious is life's journey, God attempts to guide us through the paths we determine for ourselves. And just as the lodging can disappear without warning, God reminds us how fleeting our existence is and comforts us in our time of need.

The holiday is known by several names, my favorite being Z'man Simchateinu – a time for celebrating. We have just completed our High Holiday observance and we are satisfied that our expressions of contriteness and our wishes for a better tomorrow have been accepted. It is certainly a cause for jubilee.

Additionally, Sukkot gives us the opportunity to succeed in our efforts to understand that all is not good nor is everything bad. We need to learn that good and bad are connected, and we are the link that can separate them enough to give meaning to our lives.

Sukkot enables us to comprehend the true meaning of life: to be thankful for all the harvests of our days. And God is where God should be – in our hearts and minds, in our deeds and actions, in our relationships and understanding of each other.

Sukkot should help us realize that we are responsible for each other and that there can be no true jubilation without this moral standard.

The Rabbis loved to demonstrate this with the story of a man sitting in a boat filled with many people. All of a sudden the man began drilling a hole under his seat. The other passengers were outraged and admonished him for doing something so foolhardy. His reply was that he was drilling the hole under his seat and could not understand the commotion. Everyone exclaimed that if he continued to drill the hole the boat would fill with water and everyone would drown.

We are responsible to others for our actions and for the consequences that will result. We are responsible to God for those things that relate to our spiritual well-being. We are responsible to ourselves to ensure that our lives will have meaning and purpose.

Our lives are tenuous, our existence indeed fragile and the gift of life so temporary that we must take the time to celebrate, rejoice and give thanks. Then the ultimate blessing of the season – Sukkat Shalom – peace in our homes, which translates into peace in our lives, will be our reward.



### **The Israeli Defense Forces (IDF): Personal Experiences**

A presentation will be made by Liora Hamu, citizen of both Israel and the US, whose daughter Hadar, after graduating from Hamilton High School, elected to return to Israel to serve in the IDF. Liora will tell Hadar’s story as a combat medic, from her initial experience as a Lone Soldier, through Operation Protective Edge. Liora also served in the IDF as a member of a 'Nachal' (Pioneer Youth) unit, and was stationed at an army base on the Jordanian border.



## News from Israel

**What Would You Do?** - *Deutsche Welle* interviews Amos Oz (famous Israeli Peacenik and winner of the French Legion of Honour, the Goethe Prize, the Heinrich Heine Prize and the Israel Prize)

*Amos Oz*: I would like to begin the interview in a very unusual way: by presenting one or two questions to your readers and listeners. May I do that?

Question 1: What would you do if your neighbor across the street sits down on the balcony, puts his little boy on his lap and starts shooting machine gun fire into your nursery?

Question 2: What would you do if your neighbor across the street digs a tunnel from his nursery to your nursery in order to blow up your home or in order to kidnap your family?

I am afraid that there can be no way in the world to avoid civilian casualties among the Palestinians as long as the neighbor puts his child on the lap while shooting into your nursery.

This morning I read very carefully the charter of Hamas. It says that the Prophet commands every Muslim to kill every Jew everywhere in the world. It quotes the *Protocols of the Elders of Zion* [an anti-Semitic diatribe] and says that the Jews controlled the world....So I hardly see a prospect for a compromise between Israel and Hamas. I have been a man of compromise all my life. But even a man of compromise cannot approach Hamas and say: "Maybe we meet halfway and Israel only exists on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays."

Unlike European pacifists I never believed the ultimate evil in the world is war. In my view the ultimate evil in the world is aggression, and the only way to repel aggression is unfortunately by force. That is where the difference lies between a European pacifist and an Israeli peacenik like myself. And if I may add a little anecdote: A relative of mine who survived the Nazi Holocaust in Theresienstadt always reminded her children and her grandchildren that her life was saved in 1945 not by peace demonstrators with placards and flowers but by Soviet soldiers and submachine guns. 

